The Baltic Road Association (BRA) was established in 2014 as a non-profit organisation in Estonia. It continues cooperation of the Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian Road Administrations, which started in 1989. It also serves as a successor of the cooperation which began already in 1932.

Key aim of the BRA is to seek possibilities for mutual co-operation, namely:

- To conduct joint studies,
- To co-ordinate the work of technical expert groups,
- · To organize seminars of mutual interest,
- To organize international road conference every four years,
- To participate, if needed, in the process of harmonization of the legislation in the EU road sector.
- To co-operate with other relevant international organizations.

The work of the non-profit Association is managed by the Council, which consists of the directors of the road agencies of the three Baltic states, deputy directors general or functional directors.

In addition to the Council there are 9 Technical Committees (TC) and Working Groups (WG) of the Association:

- 3. Construction TC
- 4. Design and research WG
- 5. Traffic Safety TC
- 6. Maintenance WG

When Lithuania took over the BRA presidency, the intense period of the Covid pandemic had already ended. The live meeting format was successfully returned. Over the past year, most of TC's and WG's have met in person. All committees and working groups had online meetings as well.

Traffic Safety team was one of the most effective, as they held three meetings with colleagues from Latvia and Estonia.

During the first meeting of the BRA Council in spring of 2022, the operational guidelines of the TC and WG were discussed again. It was suggesting that the technical committees directly shoud meet more regularly (at least twice a year). Working groups supossed to meet once per year. The each report of technical committees has to be appropried by the administration. Working groups have no obligation to prepare the reports.

Also it was pointed out again the differences between committees (more work, more tangible results and more meetings) and working groups for information exchange (less work, no big reports but maybe the minutes of the meetings still, and less meetings and so on).

During the year of 2022, two meetings of the BRA Council were held, during which country reports were presented (it was reviewed such topics as how contractors keep to schedules, implement contracts, whether the impact is felt due to geopolitical events, disruption of chains, etc). It was introduced also TC and WG activities, discussions took place as well.

At the end of last year, a survey for TC and WG members was organized. The participants were asking to evaluate the already held meetings, also make suggestions and comments. The results of the survey indicate some potential process improvements, for example:

- · Schedule meetings as early as possible.
- More communication between TC/WG before and after the scheduled meeting and do not forget to share the material after the meeting.

Overall, most of participants gave a positive feedback evaluating the meetings and the relevance and value of the information they exchange. Most of the participants agreed to continue having combined format of the meetings, when part of the time is devoted to the conference, and the other part - to visiting the objects.

For more convenient exchange of information, MS Teams channel has been created, therefore after TC and WG members' contacts are updated, the channel will be launched.


