#### **Activities report**

#### Introduction

Hannu Pro Tallinn OÜ was founded established in July of the year 2007 by initiative of the parent company SIA Hannu Pro and in cooperation with Televisoonitehnika OÜ. The goal of the activity - to expand business on the territory of Estonia. The main activity of company is the solutions, design, sales and integration of professional television and video technology. In December 2007 the shareholders were exchanged and share of Televisoonitehnika OÜ was acquired by AS Telegrupp.

#### Main activities

Professional, scientific and technical activities not classified in anywhere other place – EMTAK code 74901;

Other retail sale outside of stores, stalls or markets – EMTAK code 47991.

#### Income, expenses and profit

In 2009 the sales revenue of Hannu Pro Tallinn OÜ was 3,187,923 kroons. 8.97% from sales revenue was consulting in the field of professional video equipment, and 91.03% the meditation of professional video equipment.

The net profit of the Hannu Pro Tallinn OÜ is 155,493 kroons. Expenses for purchases of goods and services are 2,353,224 kroons and other operating expenses 128,048 kroons, from which the highest cost were the national and local taxes. Depreciation of fixed assets of the company was amounted to 10,942 kroons.

#### **Employees**

In 2009 the company has in average 1 employee. The payroll in 2009 was 341,395 kroons, from which the salary for head manager was 100%. For members of the Management Board is made no payments. For members of the Management Board in case of there resignation or dismissal is no additional compensation and benefits have not been provided.

#### Goals for the next financial year

In 2010 the company will expand his business and strength his market position. In order to this is planned effectively use experience and expertise of the parent enterprise, as well as existing business partners and contacts. In addition, the plan is to increase staff as necessary, up to two per person.

#### Annexes to the annual report

## Annex 1 Accounting principles General information

This Annual Report has been completed in accordance with good accounting practice of the Republic of Estonia.

It is based on the Accounting Act and Accounting Standards Board requirements, which are mandatory for annual reports to be prepared for accounting periods beginning on 01.01.2009 and later. Income statements are prepared under the Scheme No. 1 to the income statements in Schedule 2 to the Accounting Act.

This annual report completed in Estonian kroons (EEK).

Business transactions are recorded in accordance with the principle of incurred cost at the time of their actual value. The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the accounting principles.

#### Cash

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand and in bank, bank demand deposits, short-term (maturities of less than 3 months) bank deposits and shares of money market fund, with no significant change in the value of market risk.

#### Foreign currency transactions and financial assets and liabilities fixed in foreign currency

All currencies other than the Estonian kroons are foreign currencies. Transactions denominated in foreign currency are recorded on the basis of the foreign currency exchange rates of the Bank of Estonia officially valid on the transaction date.

#### Receivables and prepayments

All other receivables (accrual incomes, loans and other short-time and long-term receivables), shall be expressed in adjusted acquisition cost. The adjusted acquisition cost of short-term receivables is generally equal to their nominal value (less any repayments and possible discounts), resulting in short-term receivables in the balance sheet shall be expressed in probably amounts.

#### Tangible assets and intangible assets

On the assumption of materiality concept the tangible fixed assets are the assets having the profitable physical life more as one year and value over 10 000 EEK. Assets with an acquisition cost of less than 10 000 kroons and estimated useful life over 1 year are recorded as low-value items under inventories before taking into use and are expensed when the assets are taken into use. Records on expensed low-value items are maintained outside of balance sheet. Tangible fixed assets are recorded at their acquisition cost, consisting of the purchase price (incl. customs fee and other not-repaid taxes) and expenditures directly related to their acquisition, which are necessary for the asset to its operating condition and location. Subsequent to initial recognition, tangible fixed assets are carried in the balance sheet at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses. The tangible fixed assets shall be expressed in balance sheet in their acquisition cost, from which the cumulative depreciation and discounts by potential impairments has been subtracted.

The subsequent expenditure on fixed assets object shall be expressed as the fixed assets when it is probable that the enterprise can get future economic benefits by these assets and if the acquisition cost of the asset can be reliably measured. Other maintenance and repair costs are expensed at moment as they occur. The fixed assets shall be accounted by an inventory list.

The depreciation shall be accounted linear on the assumption of presumable profitable physical life. Depreciation is calculated starting from moment when the property is used by management in accordance with their planned purpose and will be closed when the final value exceeds the balance cost. Following depreciation rates have been used:

- Office equipment 30-50% pro year;

#### Financial liabilities

All financial liabilities (trade payables, loans/credits, accrued expenses, issued debt securities and other short-term and long-term liabilities) shall be taken permanently into account in their acquisition cost, which include all expenses directly bounded with their acquisition. The farther expression shall be passing the adjusted acquisition cost method.

#### Imposition of taxes

In accordance with Estonian actual legislation the profit of Estonian entities is no dutiable, for that reason exist no accrued expenses like corporate income tax or liabilities. Instead of profit in Estonia shall be imposed duties on the dividends paid out from retained earnings with tax rate of 24/76 from amount of net dividends paid out.

The corporate income tax follow the paying out of dividends shall be expressed in the income statement of this period when the dividends are published irrespective of that for which period they published are or when they factually shall be paid out.

#### Related parties

The parties are be considered related if one party has control over the other party or a significant influence on business decisions of the other party, including the parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, other companies belonging to the same group of enterprises, owners, members of council and management board, their families and the companies over which the above-listed persons having control or significant influence.

#### Revenue Recognition

Revenue from the sale of is recognized at the fair value of the consideration received/receivable, taking into account all the discounts and incentives. Sales revenues are recognized when all material risks to the real estate have been transferred to the purchaser and the revenue and expenses related to the transaction can be reliably measured and the revenue probable. Revenue from the sales of services is recorded upon rendering of the service, or if the service is performed over a longer period of time, based on the percentage of completion method.
